The Engineering Department is participating in a travel survey, called the Transportation Tomorrow Survey (TTS). This survey will be conducted in our community on behalf of municipal and provincial governments.

The TTS is a voluntary travel survey consisting of either telephone or online interviews of randomly selected households in the Greater Golden Horseshoe (GGH) area. The survey will be conducted from September to December 2016. The TTS is jointly undertaken by 22 funding agencies including the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario, Metrolinx/GO Transit, the TTC, and municipalities across the Greater Toronto Area and Greater Golden Horseshoe area.

The purpose of this transportation study is to collect information on current travel habits for use in transportation planning and investment across the GGH. The TTS has been conducted every five years since 1986. All information collected is protected under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and cannot be traced to an individual household.

The enclosed letter will be mailed to each household that has been invited to participate. To ensure that City Council has the information at the same time as the public, a copy of the notification letter has been attached.
