WHEREAS; The annual observance of the Day is an opportunity for the City of Barrie to make a renewed

commitment to the principles of dignity and justice for all, in support of the implementation of the

WHEREAS: The City of Barrie Council adopts each year the City's Accessibility Plan under the Ontarians with

Disabilities Act; and
