**BY-LAW NUMBER 2018 -**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to establish Part of Lot 7, Concession 12, designated as Parts 4 and 5 on Plan 51R-41318, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe being Parts of PINs: 58733-0261 (LT) and 58733-0910 (LT) as a public highway, and to name the highway Bryne Drive.**

**WHEREAS** Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 as amended (the "Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, *inter alia*, public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the *Municipal Act*, 2001 or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to confirm its jurisdiction and to establish for the purposes of a public highway Part of Lot 7, Concession 12, designated as Parts 4 and 5 on Plan 51R-41318, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe being Parts of PINs: 58733-0261 (LT) and 58733-0910 (LT), and to name the highway Bryne Drive.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

1. **THAT** Part of Lot 7, Concession 12, designated as Parts 4 and 5 on Plan 51R-41318, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe being Parts of PINs: 58733-0261 (LT) and 58733-0910 (LT), is established as a public highway.
2. **THAT** Part of Lot 7, Concession 12, designated as Parts 4 and 5 on Plan 51R-41318, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe being Parts of PINs: 58733-0261 (LT) and 58733-0910 (LT), be named Bryne Drive and that such name be affixed at the corners of the highway.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 17<sup>th</sup> of September, 2018.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2018.
