This summer Recreation Services worked in partnership with Firebird Community Cycle, a communitybased, not-for-profit, do-it-yourself bike shop and recycling depot. Firebird Community Cycle is dedicated to the promotion of bicycle education and culture through the sustainable and accessible rebuilding, reusing, recycling and redistribution of all bicycle products.

They resurrect and recycle bikes, accept donations of bikes and parts, and teach the residents of the community how to properly fix and maintain their bikes on a pay-what-you-can fee structure. The program also provides the opportunity for individuals to customize their bikes or build a bike from a collection of donated parts. Firebird Community Cycle provides access to specialized bike tools and expertise.

From late June to early September, Firebird Cycle set up their mobile bike repair workshop in our Community Centre parking lots. These outdoor locations were chosen to maximize community engagement, to promote cycling as an accessible form of transportation, and to provide an opportunity for residents to create their own mode of transportation. Over 130 residents came out and experienced what Firebird Cycle can do to support cycling as a sustainable, active transportation opportunity in the City of Barrie.
