Fire Prevention Week October 7 to 13

Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware. Fire can happen anywhere.

(Barrie, ON) Fire Prevention Week is October 7 to 13 and Barrie Fire and Emergency Service (BFES) reminds residents to **look** for places fire could start, **listen** for the sound of the smoke alarm and **learn** two ways out of every room. This year, BFES teamed up with Cornwall Fire Services to launch a joint music video. Watch firefighters sing along to a special fire safety version of "<u>I Gotta Feeling</u>" that reminds viewers to have a good night by preventing fires before they happen, installing and maintaining smoke and carbon monoxide alarms and planning and practising their home escape plan.

Residents are encouraged to take part in the following events and activities throughout the week:

October 8 – 19	TVO Kids Push 2 Buttons Campaign! BFES, the Office of the Fire Marshal and TVOKids are teaming up to encourage everyone to test their smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms. Kids can visit <u>tvokids.com</u> to enter the number of alarms they've tested in the interactive counter.
