I, JEFF LEHMAN, Mayor of the City of BARRIE,

do hereby proclaim

**November 15, 2018**

as

## Pancreatic Cancer Day

- WHEREAS;** In 2018, an estimated 5,500 people will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in Canada and 93 percent will eventually die from the disease; and
- WHEREAS;** Pancreatic cancer has the lowest survival rate of all major cancers, and just 7 percent of those diagnosed survive five years or longer; and
- WHEREAS;** Pancreatic cancer is the seventh most common cause of cancer-related death across the world; and
- WHEREAS;** It is estimated that by 2020, 480,000 new cases will be diagnosed globally; and
- WHEREAS;** The good health and well-being of the residents of Barrie are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about the risks and symptoms of pancreatic cancer, and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments.
- THEREFORE,** I, Jeff Lehman, Mayor of the City of Barrie, do hereby proclaim **November 15, 2018** as **"Pancreatic Cancer Day"** in the City of Barrie.
