



BY-LAW NUMBER 2019-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the “as-constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Nathan Infill Subdivision, registered as 51M-1037 and to assume the streets for public use.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the “Municipal Act, 2001”), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume Nathan Crescent, being all of PIN 58737-3152(LT) and Booth Lane, being all of PIN 58737-3151(LT), located within the limits of the Nathan Infill Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-1037;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to accept the “as constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Nathan Infill Subdivision as identified on Appendix “A” attached to this By-law;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Nathan Crescent, being all of PIN 58737-3152(LT) and Booth Lane, being all of PIN 58737-3151(LT), within the limits of the Nathan Infill Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-1037, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe, be assumed for public use.
2. **THAT** the “as constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Nathan Infill Subdivision registered as Plan 51M-1037 as identified on Appendix “A” attached to this By-law be accepted.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 12th day of August, 2019.

READ a third time and finally passed this 12th day of August, 2019.
