- Provincial subsidy increases have not kept pace with nursing and other staffing related costs

Paramedic Services: +\$795K

- Staffing additions for increased call volume (\$553K)
- 16 FTE's: 1 24/7 and 2 12/7 ambulances
- Barrie call volume is 36% of the total calls

Operating Budget Highlights



Ontario Works: -\$628K

- Provincial funding increased to 91.4% in 2015 compared to 88.6% in 2014 with an estimated savings for Barrie of \$606K
- Ontario Works projected caseload in 2015 consistent with 2014 at 7,400.

Children & Community Services: -\$13K

- Increase in caseloads results in an estimated increase of \$77K.

Operating Budget Highlights



Social Housing Non Profit: +\$203K

- Loans to Social Housing providers for necessary capital repairs, Building Condition Assessment used as a guideline (\$81K)
- Provider subsidy payments increase as a result of annual increases in Provincial indices (\$91K)

Simcoe County Housing Corporation: +\$22K

 Mandatory 1.6% annual rent increase established by the rent control guidelines result in a slight increase over the 2014 budget

Simcoe County Housing Corporation: -\$480K

- Reflective of the asset management plan
- Brooks Street Intensification Project continued in 2015 at \$4.3M (Total project \$11.6M providing 54 addition units)
