Ontario Works: -\$1.295M

- Provincial funding increased to 97.2% in 2017 compared to 94.2% in 2016 with an estimated savings for Barrie of \$778K
- Ontario Works projected caseload in 2017 at 6,600

Children & Community Services: \$34K

- Increase of \$3.7M in Child Care funding from the Ministry of Education and \$552K Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative funding from Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing

Social Housing Non Profit: -\$4K

- Reduction of loans to Social Housing providers for necessary capital repairs, as identified in the Building Condition Assessment
- Implementation of Long Term Affordable Housing and Homelessness Prevention Strategy
- Investments in Affordable Housing Extension & Social Infrastructure
 Fund \$13.3M (100% funded)

Simcoe County Housing Corporation: \$124K

Increased utility costs in 2017 budget







Simcoe County Housing Corporation: \$914K

- Collingwood Re-development 147 units:
 - Construction start in 2017
 - 30 replacement Social Housing units
 - 117 new affordable housing units
 - Ontario Works/Children Services satellite office
