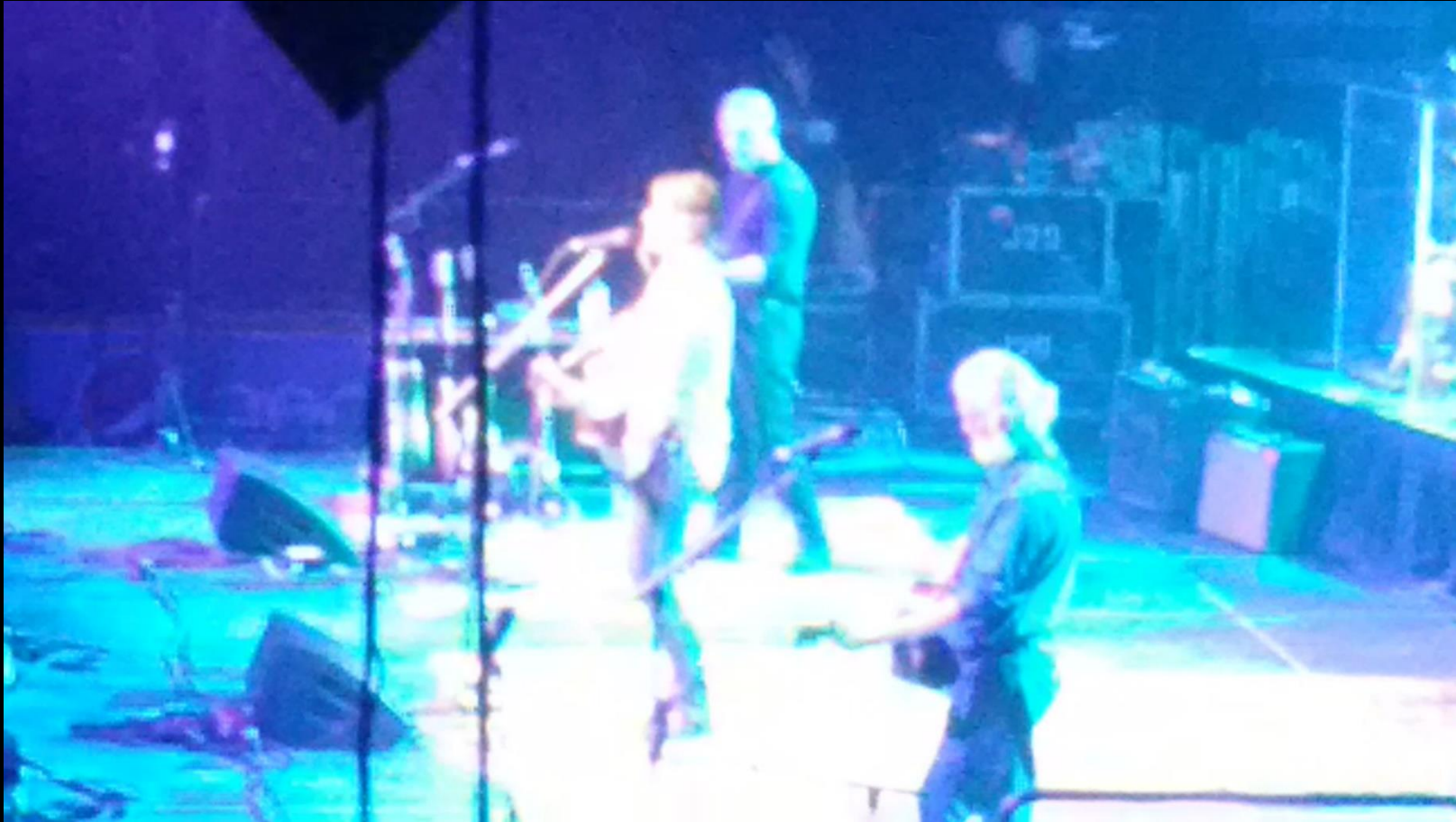

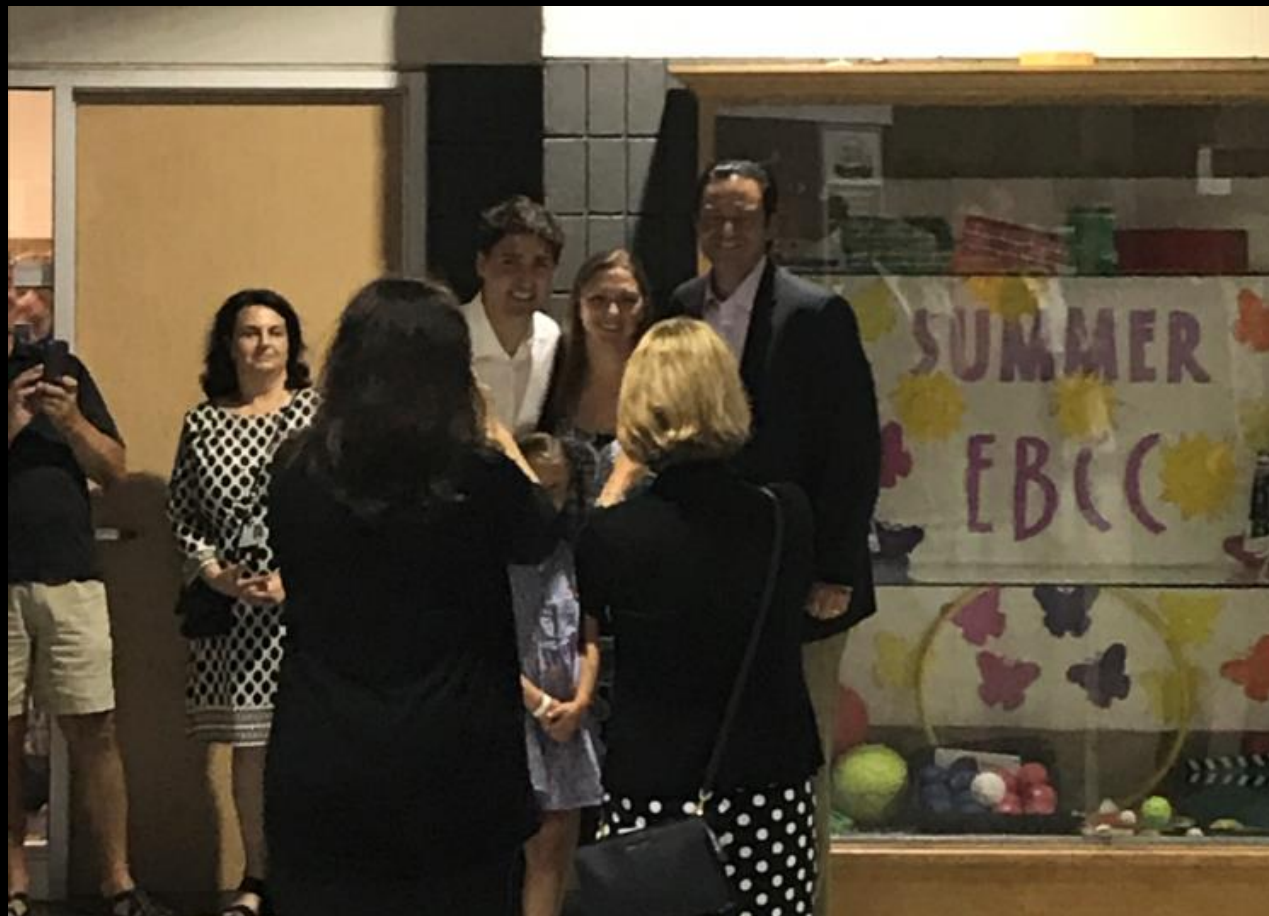

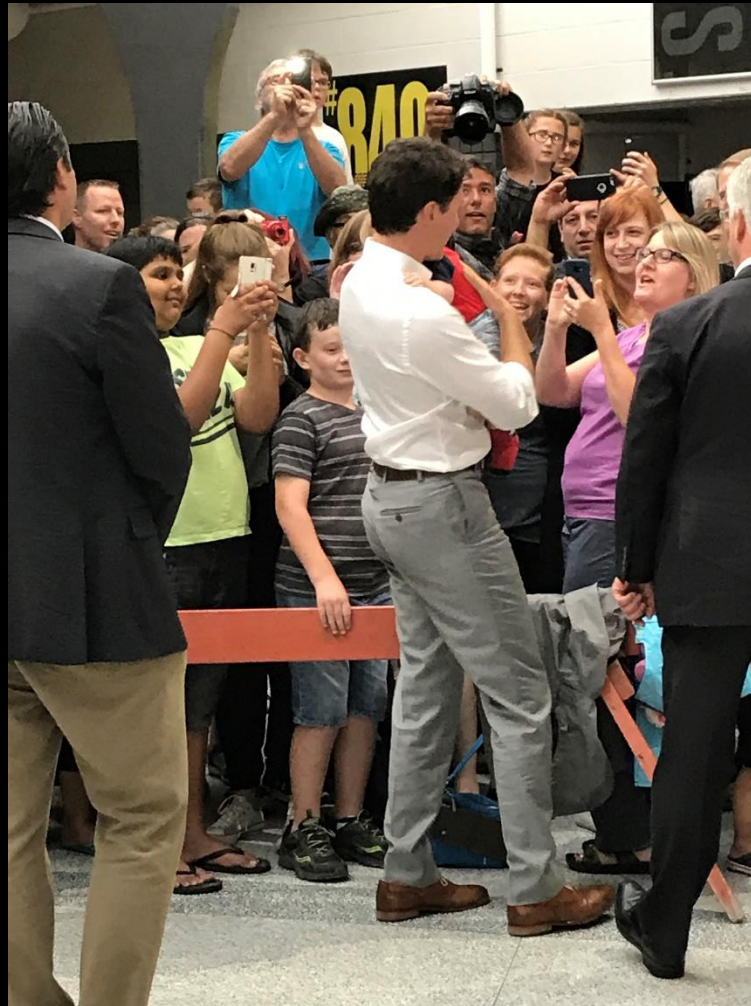

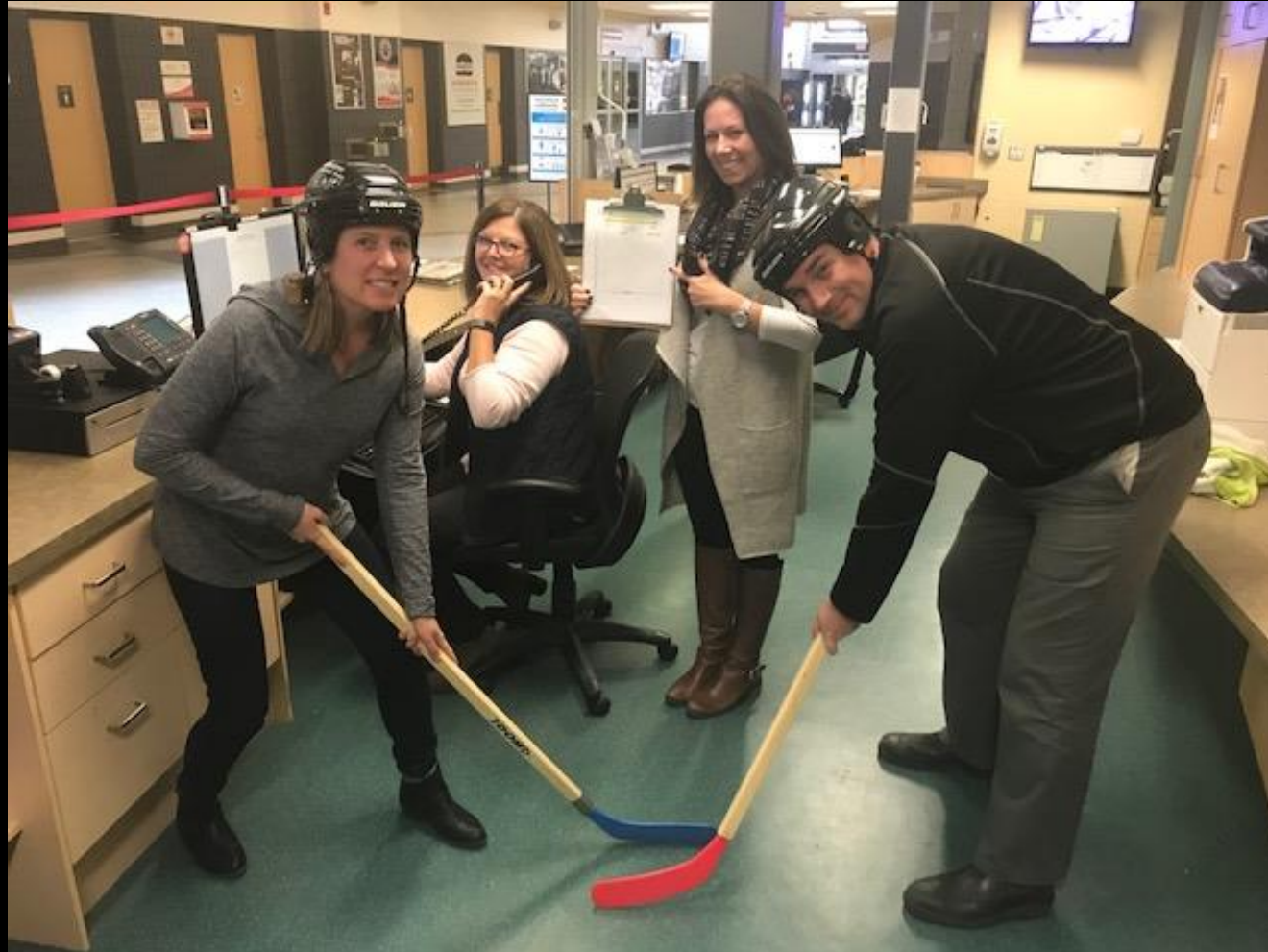

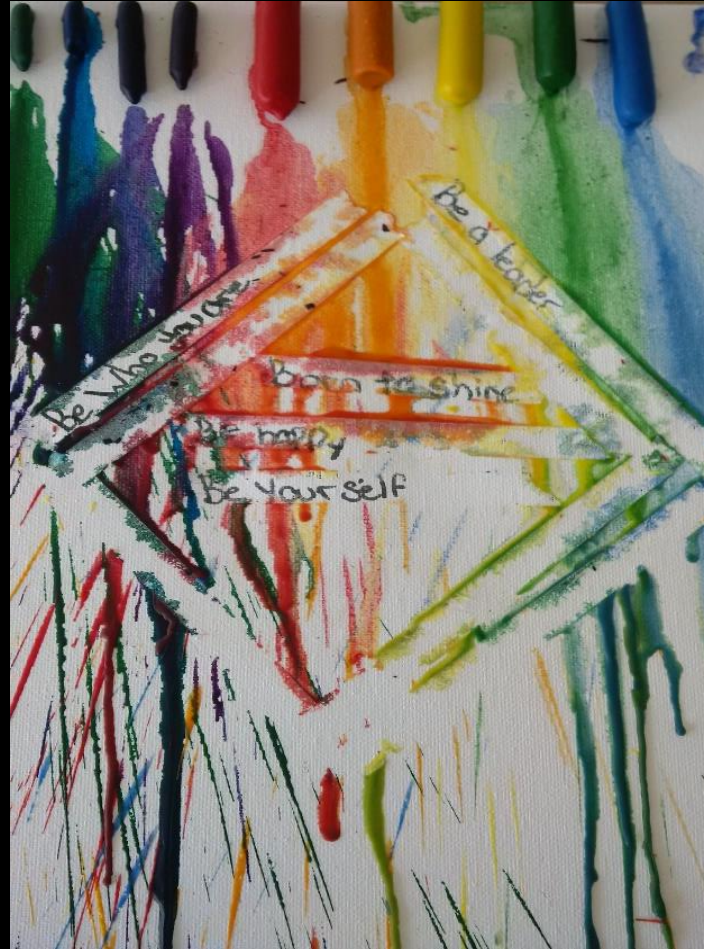


# Barrie Municipal non Profit Housing Partnership
