WHEREAS; April is Parkinson's Awareness Month and April 11th as World Parkinson's Day; and

WHEREAS; Parkinson's is a disease of the brain that touches almost every aspect of daily living including movement, mood, speech, eating, drinking, sleep, and cognition.

Parkinson's is a progressive chronic disease that results in a loss of independence and premature death with no known cure; and

WHEREAS: Parkinson's is the fastest-growing neurological condition in the world affecting 100,000

Canadians. The number of people diagnosed each day with Parkinson's in Canada will rise to over 50 in the next 10 years. Parkinson's is the most prevalent neurodegenerative movement disorder. Parkinson's disease impacts the lives of thousands of families and care partners. Timely access to care and treatments makes the difference between living well and experiencing hardship. must engage in helping friends, family and neighbours living with Parkinson's; and
