

BY-LAW NUMBER 2020-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to accept the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Baywood Homes Subdivision Registered as Plan 51M-0906 as shown in the attached map, and to assume the streets within this plan of subdivision for public use.

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the *"Municipal Act*, 2001"), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the *Municipal Act*, 2001 or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume those parts of Commonwealth Road, Coronation Parkway, Monarchy Street, Majesty Boulevard and Sun King Crescent on Plan 51M-0906, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as shown on Schedule "A" attached;

AND WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Development Services or designate to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** those parts of Commonwealth Road, Coronation Parkway, Monarchy Street, Majesty Boulevard and Sun King Crescent, on Plan 51M-0906, as shown on Schedule "A" attached be assumed for public use.
- THAT the "as-constructed" municipal services within and complementary to the Baywood Homes subdivision - Commonwealth Road, Coronation Parkway, Monarchy Street, Majesty Boulevard and Sun King Crescent on Plan 51M-0906, within the section shown on Schedule "A" attached, be accepted.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 27th day of April, 2020.

READ a third time and finally passed this 27th day of April, 2020.
