ZONING BY-LAW UPDATE - SENIORS HOUSING

C. Terry, Planner reviewed a proposed change to Zoning By-law 2009-141 concerning the definition of seniors public housing. Ms. Terry explained that, in the housekeeping changes to Zoning By-law 2009-141, the proposed definition for Assisted Living Facility is based primarily on land use.
