Nominations open April 5 for Mayor's Innovation Awards

(Barrie, ON) – Nominations for the fifth annual Mayor's Innovation Awards are now open. These awards celebrate the year's most creative solutions from businesses, individuals, and community groups in Barrie. The theme of these awards is "Beyond the New Normal," encouraging stories of strength, creativity and adaptation.

"I continue to be impressed by the creativity, innovation, and determination of our business and community leaders, especially post pandemic," said Mayor Alex Nuttall. "It speaks volumes to the environment that we've been able to create in Barrie–one that encourages and celebrates leadership and collaboration within the community. The deadline to submit a nomination is May 28, 2023 at 11:59 p.m.
