2024 COMMUNITIES IN BLOOM PROGRAM

The committee discussed the judge's itinerary for the CIB event in July, which included finalizing the locations around the city that will be toured. The judges will be having lunch at a local Heritage House and visiting different garden displays throughout the community. Councillor Kungl will send an invite out to all the city department heads to invite a representative from their department to attend the event and highlight to the judges what the different departments have accomplished. The departments are being asked to attend from 1:30-3pm to allow time for setup and take down. Each department will have a small table to hang some banners and any information about upcoming projects. M. Boyd will provide the members with a list of locations around the city that still need to be photographed as part of the wall display at the event.
