**The Town and Gown Committee met and reports as follows:**

**GENERAL UPDATES**

J. Van Wieringen, Zoning Officer provided the Committee with an update concerning property standards and zoning enforcement complaints. He noted that he is unable to obtain exact reporting numbers for property complaints as the Building Services Department is currently going through a reorganization. He noted that one zoning summer student has been hired to assist with property complaints.

B. Keene, Municipal Law Enforcement Officer I, provided the Committee with an update regarding Boarding, Lodging and Rooming Houses (BLR's). He noted that activity is little slower since the College students are out for the summer. Officer Keene stated that five summer students have been hired as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.

B. Bowles, Barrie Police Services provided the Committee with an update regarding noise and disturbance complaints within the Georgian College area. He noted that there were minimal noise complaints with the exception of the long weekend

Officer Bowles announced that he has now been appointed as the Georgian College Liasion on behalf of the Barrie Police Service.

There was no update provided by Georgian College.

The Committee asked questions regarding the information provided and received responses from staff.
