Executive Summary:

The purpose of this report is to propose a new Library Budget Requirements Policy in response to Council Direction Memo 25-G-015 (#4):

That staff in the Finance Department develop a list of reporting requirements to be followed by the Barrie Public Library Board when presenting their annual budget request to City Council and report back to Finance and Responsible Governance with this list.

The proposed policy can be found in Appendix A.

Key Findings:

Staff in the Finance Department developed a list of reporting requirements in consultation with staff at the Barrie Public Library Board ("Library"). Staff determined that a Council Policy would be the best method to formalize the reporting requirements. The proposed policy specifies the form in which the Library shall submit its annual budget to Council, and will result in consistent, detailed financial information being provided to aid in Council's financial oversight of funding provided by the City to the Library.
