## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2021-**

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend By-law 2021-044 being a By-law to set tax capping parameters for 2021 for properties in the multi-residential, commercial and industrial property classes.

**WHEREAS** Section 329.1 of the *Municipal Act* 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "*Municipal Act*, 2001"), permits municipalities to pass a by-law to establish taxes based on the criteria and capping provisions provided therein;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 330(1) of the *Municipal Act* 2001, authorizes a single tier municipality to pass a by-law to establish a percentage by which tax decreases are limited for a tax year that are in the Commercial, Industrial and Multi-residential tax classes;

**AND WHEREAS** By-law 2021-044 being a by-law to set tax capping parameters for 2020 for properties in the multi-residential, commercial and industrial property classes was adopted on June 15, 2020.

**AND WHEREAS** by motion 21-G-135 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to amend By-law 2021-044 to establish the 2021 clawback percentages;

1. **THAT** By-law 2021-044 be amended by adding the following as paragraph 4 and renumbering the remaining paragraphs accordingly:

**"THAT** the 2021 property tax clawback percentages for properties for affected properties in the Commercial and Industrial be established as follows:

a) Commercial 0.000000%; and

b) Industrial 0.000000%."

THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2021.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2021.
