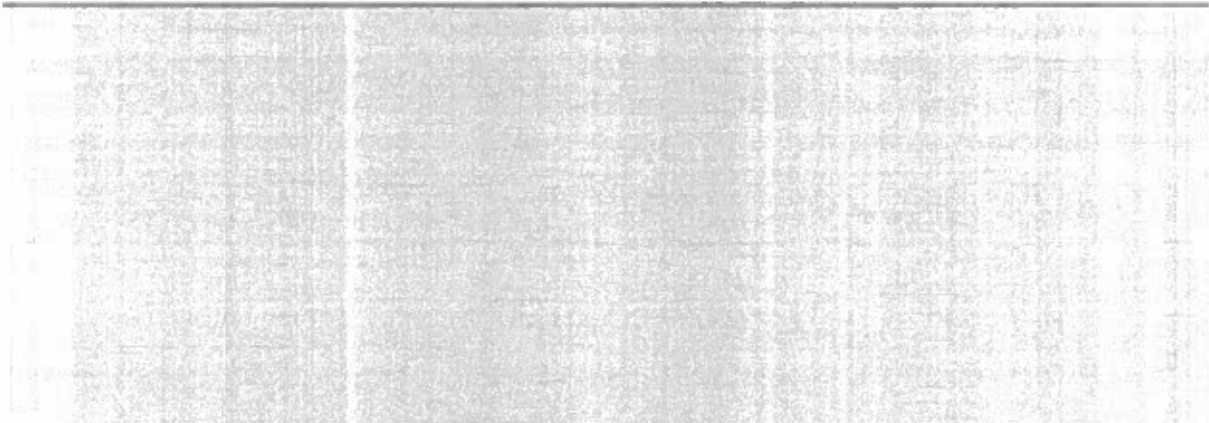

This home was built in 1907 and shows up in the early hand drawn archival maps dated 1907, found at the <sup>County Archives</sup> Lincoln County. It has what we believe to be the original hardwood floors, many in patterned layout. There are multiple transoms, with stained or artistically designed glass. These ~~are~~ original 13" baseboards are unpainted, as <sup>are</sup> ~~is~~ most of the ~~the~~ wooden features (including massive pocket doors) on the main floor. We have been able to trace the property parcel back to ~~date~~ <sup>the</sup> 1893. ~~the~~ The first owner recorded was James Patten who operated the Barne Herald & was a Q.C. & solicitor general.
