CULTURE PLAN AND PUBLIC ART STRATEGY UPDATE

Amanda Dyke, Culture Development Officer reported that an RFP was put out to retain consultants to provide a Culture Plan update and deliver a Public Art Strategy.

Ms. Dyke advised that the primary goal is to establish a clearly defined plan and associated actions over ten years and will be developed in consultation with City staff, the arts and culture community, key stakeholders, and
