







2018 30 applicants living in 14 municipalities within Simcoe **County received** funding



Accessible, Adaptable and Inclusive Designs for Occupants 60+

The County of Simcoe has established an annual fund in the amount of \$500,000 for eligible Seniors Housing Grant Program projects, Grant amounts will be distributed based on the number of applications received and ability to meet funding criteria.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

If you are interested in applying for an Age-Friendly Seniors Housing Grant, you must meet the following

- Housing Projects must be located within the 16 municipalities of the County of Simcoe; excludes cities of Barrie and Orillia.
- Applicants can be homeowners of principal residences or developers
- Housing must be dedicated to occupants 60 years and older
- Individual homes or multi-residential development projects You have not already received capital funding from the County of Simcoe for the same

DESIGN FOR PEOPLE SUFFERING DEMENTIA

Housing design reflecting the best practices of Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation, Housing Options for People Living with Dementia, Volumes 1, 2, 3 and/or Dementia Services Development Centre, Improving the Design of Housing to Assist People with Dementia Criteria

SUPPORT SERVICES

Grants for the provision of housing support to meet daily needs such as:

- Social and physical activities
- Meal preparation
- Housekeeping and/or laundry
- Personal health care services, such as bathing.
- grooming, dressing and taking medication 24-hour supervision and emergency response

Note: Information in this Fact Sheet is subject to change from time to time at the discretion of the County of Simose Note: \$500,000 is the maximum amount available to distribute between all projects approved for funding



Soup from Seniors program was developed to strengthen relationships within the community by providing practical support to vulnerable people within the area.










