That staff in Legislative Services be directed to prepare a Rental Housing Bylaw similar to the Waterloo Rental Housing Bylaw including an implementation plan for consideration by General Committee.

Link to Vision:

Encourage a range of housing options to make housing attainable

Reason or Rationale in support of the motion:

- 1. Protect Barrie housing stock so that it remains affordable for Barrie residents
- 2. Protecting the investment of families in established neighbourhoods
- 3. Keeping family housing affordable by encouraging purpose built student housing
- 4. Reducing pressure on our enforcement services to enforce bylaws that are difficult to enforce.
- 5. Protecting vulnerable tenants from exploitation
- 6. Improving the property standards of our community
- 7. Moving from an after the fact enforcement approach to a pro-active compliance approach
- 8. Leveling the rental playing field by regulating better the "grey" market
- 9. Reducing the number of illegal Boarding, Lodging and Rooming houses
- 10. Improving fire safety in the community
