The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:

COMMUNITIES IN BLOOM COMMITTEE COMPETITION

M. Boyd provided an outline of the activities associated with the Communities in Bloom Competition. Councillor Jackson described the Heritage component of the competition.
