Queens Park neighbourhood construction and road closures starting next week

(Barrie, ON) – The City of Barrie's Queens Park neighbourhood will be under construction starting June 24 to reconstruct and upgrade infrastructure, and relocate the Sophia Creek culvert. This area contains some of the oldest infrastructure in the city.

This project is part of Barrie's <u>Historic Neighbourhoods Strategy Queens Park area</u> reconstruction. Watermains, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and roads in this neighbourhood need to be updated to improve service levels.

The following road closures will be in effect:

- Ross Street and Sophia Street intersection
 Ross Street will be closed between Toronto Street and Mary Street from June 24 until August 5, 2024.

For both of these closures, residents who live within the affected area will have access, and emergency vehicle access will be maintained. Detours will be in place.

Barrie Transit routes will be on detour for both of these closures. Visit <u>myridebarrie.ca/news</u> for transit updates.
