The free event brought nearly 140,000 attendees to the shores of Kempenfelt Bay and downtown Barrie, contributing over \$11.3M to the local economy. Sport Tourism is the fastest growing segment in the tourism industry globally and a \$7.4B market in Canada, according to Sport Tourism Canada. In Barrie, the City's Tourism Master Plan identifies the development of a sport tourism strategy that outlines, "... the structure and resources required to attract and host sport events that positively impact the Barrie brand and community..." Together with Tourism Barrie and Sport Tourism Canada, the City of Barrie completed the Sport Tourism Strategy which was then adopted by Barrie City Council on October 23, 2024.
