TAIZHOU, CHINA UPDATE

A report was not provided regarding Taizhou, China.

GERMAN TWINNING AND GERMAN CANADIAN CLUB REPORT

J.M. Pigeon provided an update regarding the German Twinning. Mr. Pigeon commented that an orchestra band from Zweibrücken Germany will be visiting the City of Barrie from October 11, 2016 to October 21, 2016.
