GIS is more than just maps, it creates:

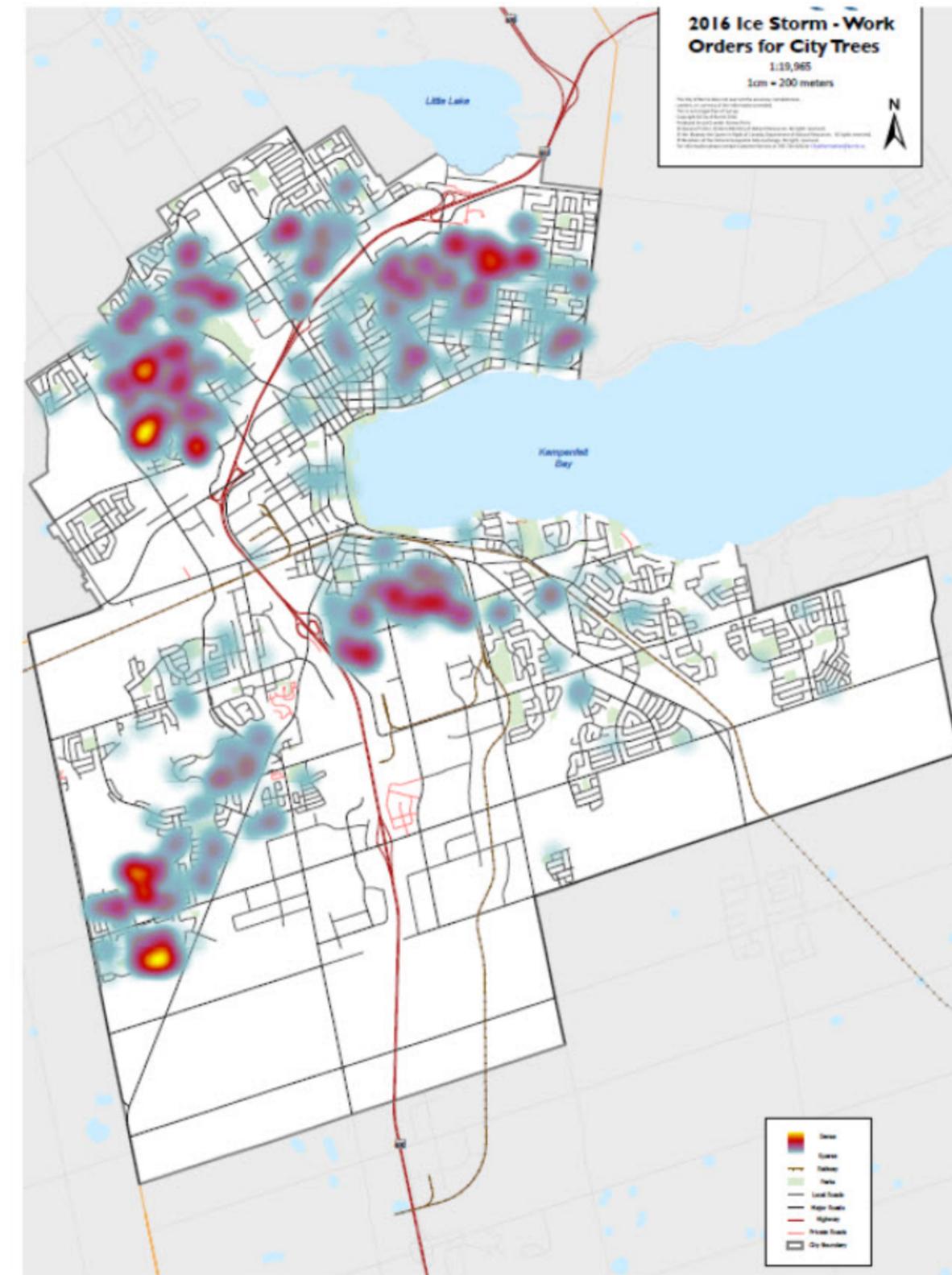
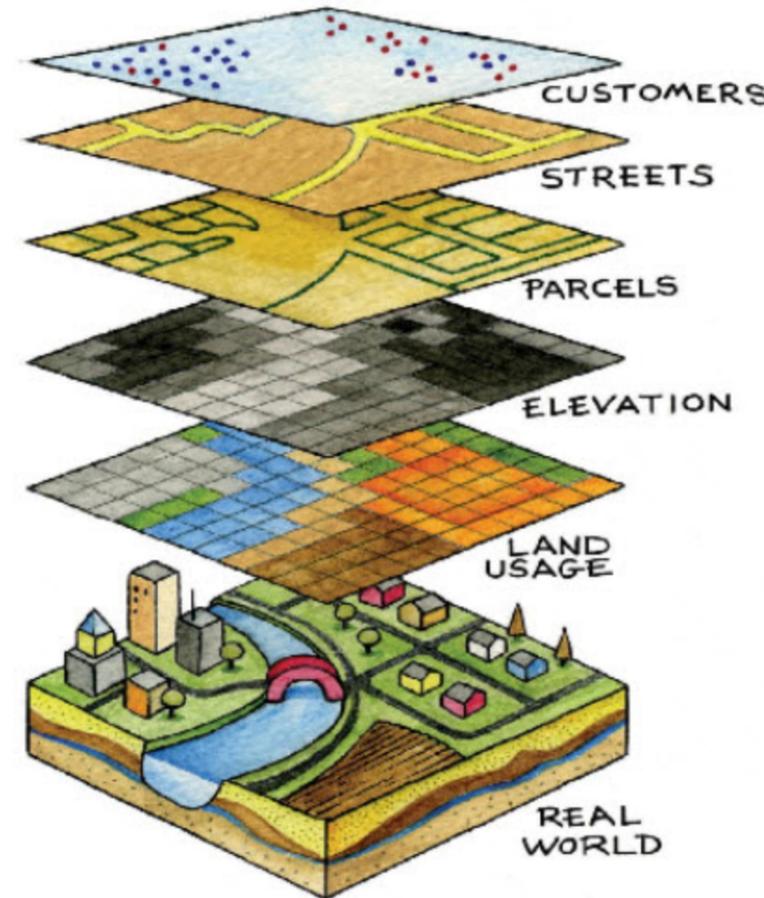
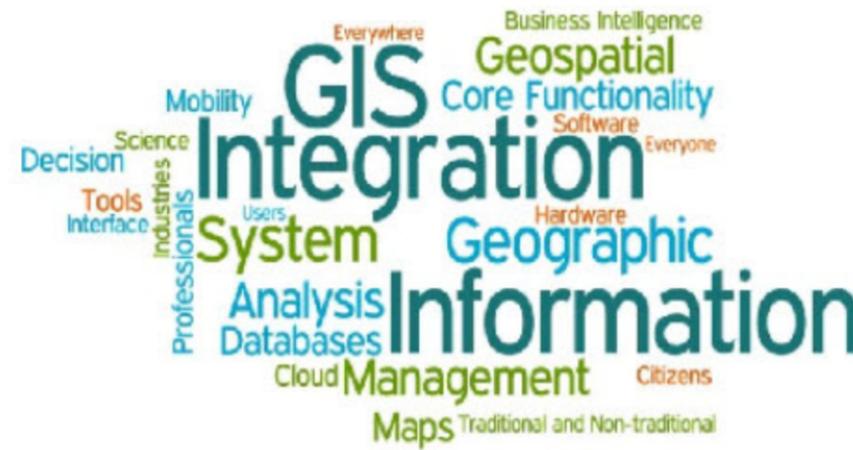

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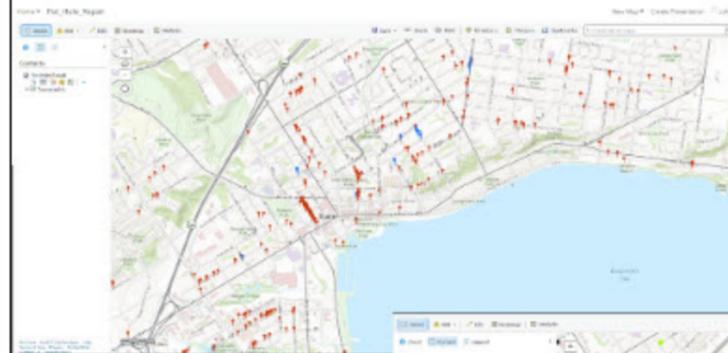
- **Staff Field Applications** - Pot Hole, Sod Repair, Engineering Inspections
- **3D Modelling** - Line of sight, shadow impacts, visualization
- **Corporate Applications** - Water and Roads Operations, Building and Planning Applications, Licenses, Permits, Inspections
- **Growth Management** - Core information gathering, data validation and presentation
- **Emergency Services** - Fire dispatch and prevention
- **Asset Management** - Asset repository for corporate infrastructure
- **Data Capture** - Field verified accurate information
- **Spatial Analysis** - Understanding data trends and patterns

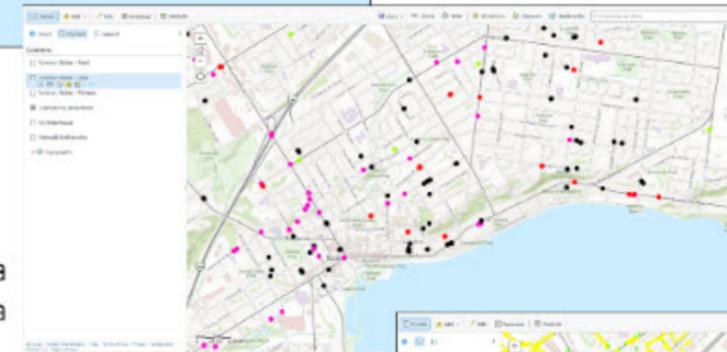
- Find bus routes, zoning, boundaries, properties for sale, property information, road closures and much more.



Pothole Repairs

The **Pothole Repairs** app enables field workers to record repair details to both reported and discovered potholes. In the field City staff can easily see, in real time, where potholes have been identified that require fixing.

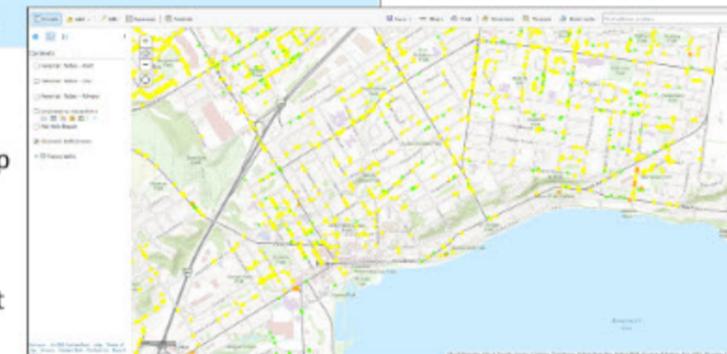
Using **ArcGIS Online** and **Collector for ArcGIS** the GIS Branch was able to develop a series of mobile capable data collection applications to allow Operations Staff to greatly increase their efficiency and operations monitoring of several key Surface maintenance tasks.



Engineering Inspections

With the **Engineering Inspections** app we manage our annual maintenance contract with the Engineering team. For the first time, repair locations are being spatially recorded.

The **Sidewalk Deficiencies** app allows for easy coordination throughout the repair/replacement cycle of damaged Sidewalk assets that were identified during our annual sidewalk patrol

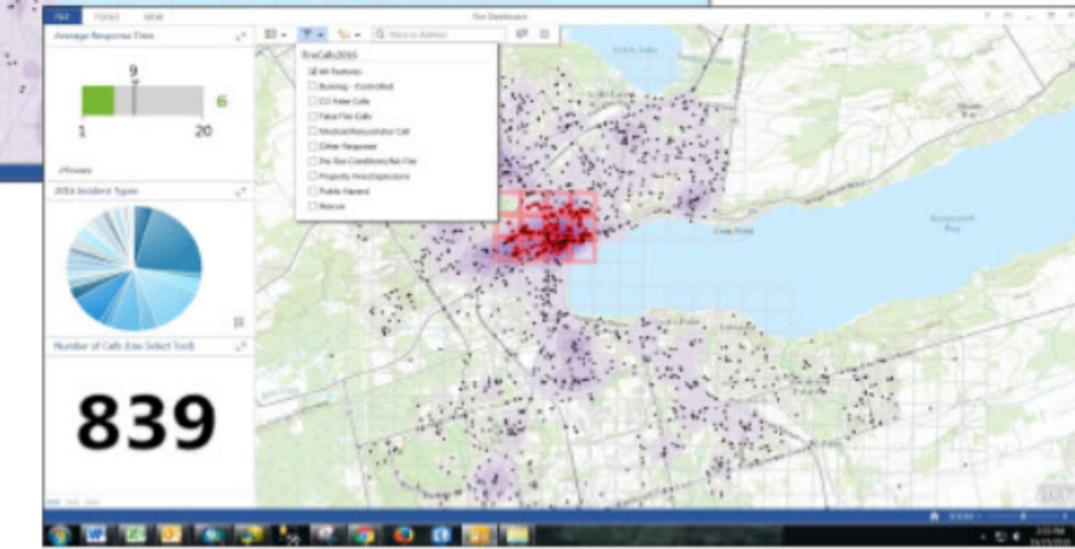

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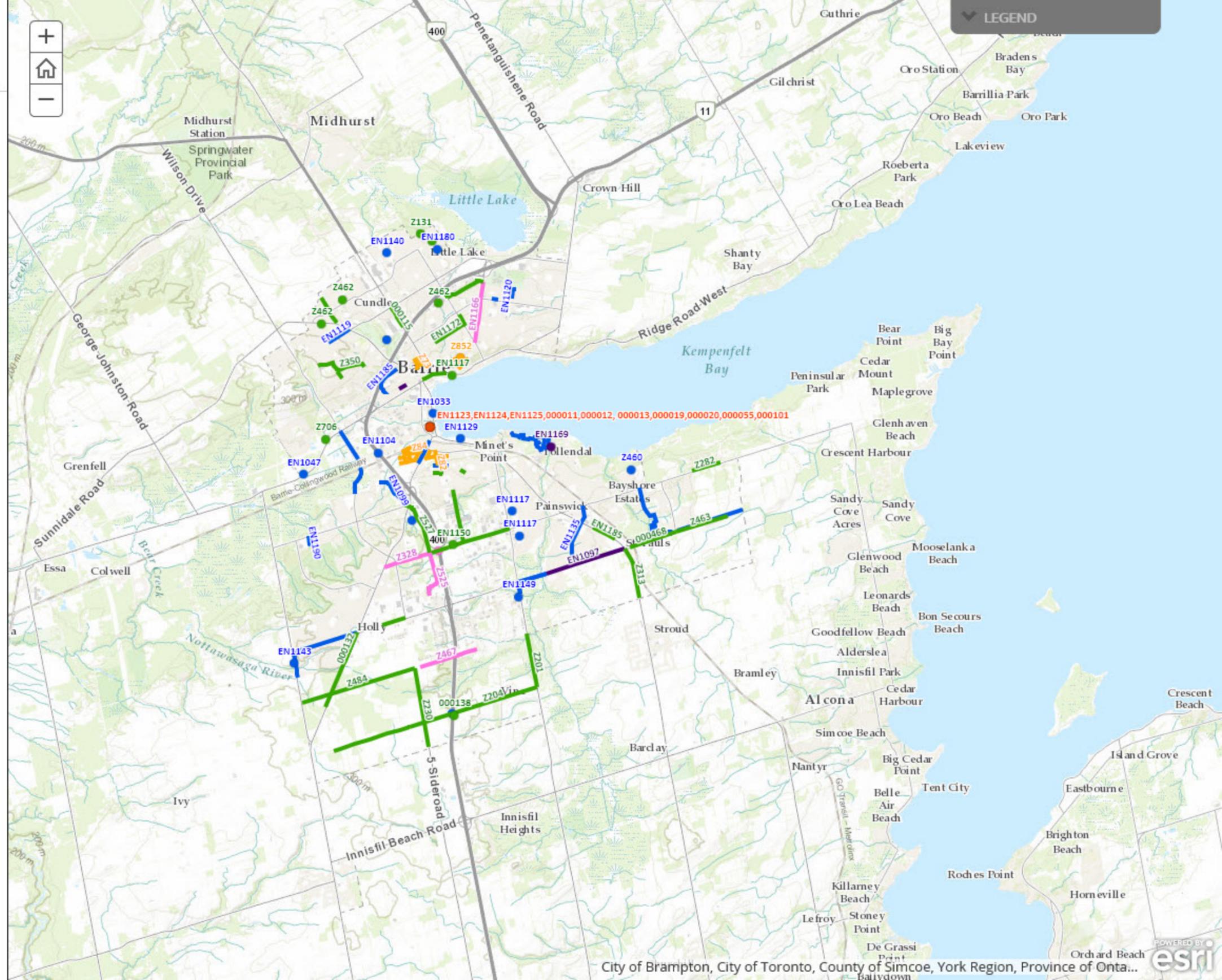
Open GIS Portal

- Addresses
- Wards
- Zoning
- Parks
