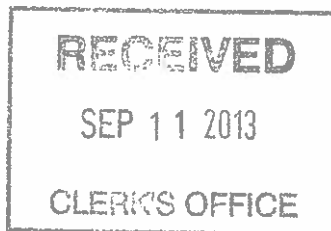

I will be asking what consideration has been given to the conservation and management of these long standing natural habitats and what steps will be taken to ensure strict compliance with environmental legislation and regulation.

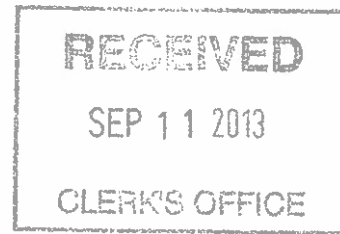

Mayor and Members of Council:

We received the NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING concerning the application by Steve Stapleton of Auburn Development Inc. to redesignate the subject lands from Agriculture (A) and Environmental Protection (EP) to Residential Single Detached Third Density (R3) and Residential Multiple (RM2).

We are strongly opposed to this proposal and in particular the rezoning of the first block, Phase 2, located at the corner of Ardagh Road and Wright Drive. There is a majestic stand of pines on this land and we believe it should remain zoned as Environmental Protection (EP).

Today, when there is a global initiative towards sustainable environmental practices, why a developer would buy land that is zoned (EP) and expect to have the land rezoned for residential seems rather irresponsible.

Our ancestors had the foresight to set this land aside and to plant these beautiful trees. Previous politicians even had the sense to zone this land as Environmental Protection (EP). The very least we can do is to continue to respect their decisions.

We urge the General Committee of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Barrie to not approve this application to rezone.
