- 1. That the City's Urban Forrester be requested to review 147 Toronto Street site and provide a memorandum to the Development Services Committee on the sustainability of the southern portion of the property as a wooded area from a heritage preservation perspective.
- 2.   - a) The inclusion of a list the significant Heritage attributes /features applicable to the building on the northern half of the property, based on the building features and attributes referenced in the description of Schedule B, "Reasons for Designation" to By-law 92 -33; and
  - b) Exclude the southern half as a designated portion.
