### **GARBAGE DISPOSAL - GARBURATORS**

P. Bursztyn, Chair discussed with the Committee the benefits of installing garburators in homes versus the City of Barrie Green Bin program.

The Committee suggested a pilot project in order to get results and see the outcome of the installations. The Committee agreed to invite staff from the Environmental Services Department to attend a future meeting for further discussion.

The Committee discussed the idea of a "Green City" initiative for the City of Barrie. It was noted that the Climate Change Strategy is similar to the Green City Initiative and that further investigation will be needed.
