Motion for Consideration:

That staff in the Development Services Department investigate the feasibility and approximate costs of installing a crosswalk at corner of Toronto Street and Park Street and report back to the Active Transportation and Sustainability Committee.

Reason or Rationale in support of the motion:

Toronto Street does not have a safe crossing area from the intersection of Dunlop Street moving north to Ross Street.
