Successful Applicants To Date



2023/2024 – targeted grant submission. 12 organizations targeted, 6 submitted and 3 funded totaling \$150,000



2024/2025 – open call for proposals. 18 organizations submitted, 11 received funding for a total of \$570,000

Eligibility



Proposals which align with the four key principles: Strengthen Community Bonds, Targeted Audience, Pro-Social Activities and Sustainability.



Provide services within the boundaries of the City of Barrie and have a track record of positive impact.



Proposed initiatives need to be new or enhanced and should be modeled from the four key principles.



Partnerships are encouraged and require a signed letter of intent to partner.

Salaries, Wages and Benefits

Recruitment and training costs associated to staff and volunteers

Conference rooms and meeting room rentals

Travel, accommodation, and related expenses

Office equipment supplies and materials.

Translation and Simultaneous Interpretation Costs

Meal and/or Refreshments for participants

2025-2026 Funding Timeline

- Available funding: \$150,000
- Open Call for submission: November 7th to December 6th, 2024
- Community Safety Committee adjudication of submissions: Dec '24 Jan '25
- Community Safety Committee Final Review and Award January 2025
- Organizations notified of their funding agreement February 2025
- Funding period April 1, 2025, March 31, 2026
