**RECOMMENDED MOTION**

1. That Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "A" "No Parking Any Time" be amended and add the following:

"Berczy Street East side Collier Street to Dunlop Street Any Time

2. That Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "B" "No Parking in Specified Places Where Signs on Display at Stated Times" be amended and delete the following:

"Berczy Street East side in front of St. Mary's School Grounds 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays."

3. That Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended and delete the following:

"Codrington Street South side from a point 90 metres east of Berczy Street to Donald Street Two (2) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory holidays"

"Collier Street South side from Poyntz Street to Berczy Street Two (2) hours from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."

And add the following:

<u>"Codrington Street</u>	South side from a point 90 metres east of Berczy Street to Dundonald Street	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory holidays"
<u>"Collier Street</u>	South side from Poyntz Street to Berczy Street	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."
<u>"Amelia Street</u>	North side from Berczy Street to the east limit	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."

**PURPOSE & BACKGROUND**

4. In a review of overflow parking from the Downtown Core in front of residential housing staff are recommending implementing a three (3) hour parking limit on Amelia Street, Berczy Street, Collier Street and Codrington Street to address overflow parking and improve on-street parking for residents.

5. On September 12, 2011 City Council adopted Motion 11-G-247 regarding investigation of a three (3) hour maximum parking in Eugenia Street, Duckworth Street, Amelia Street, Theresa Street, Dundonald Street, Berczy Street, and Poyntz Street which states:

“That staff in the Engineering Department investigate the feasibility of restricting parking to a limit of three hours, between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm on the following street: Eugenia between Albert and Duckworth Streets. Duckworth from St. Vincent to Amelia Street, Amelia from Duckworth Street to Albert Street, Theresa from Dundonald to Berczy, Dundonald from Codrington to Theresa, Albert from Codrington to Amelia Street, and Berczy and Poyntz streets between Collier and Codrington; and report back to General Committee”.

6. The purpose of this investigation was to review the parking impacts of overflow parking from the Downtown Core in front of residential houses, please refer to Appendix “A” for a map of the study area.

**ANALYSIS**

**ALBERT STREET – CODRINGTON STREET TO AMELIA STREET**

7. Albert Street between Codrington Street and Amelia Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.0 metres and no sidewalks.
8. Parking is prohibited on both sides of Albert Street between Codrington Street and Amelia Street Monday to Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. excluding Statutory Holidays.
9. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 12 property owners on Albert Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

10. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulations on Albert Street from Codrington Street to Amelia Street at this time.

**ALBERT STREET – COLLIER STREET TO DUNLOP STREET**

11. Albert Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and a sidewalk on the east side.
12. Parking is prohibited anytime on the west side of Albert Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street.
13. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 43 property owners on Albert Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

14. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulations on Albert Street from Collier Street to Dunlop Street at this time.

**AMELIA STREET – ALBERT STREET TO DUCKWORTH STREET**

15. Amelia Street between Albert Street and Duckworth Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and no sidewalks.
16. Currently, parking is prohibited anytime on the south side of Amelia Street between Albert Street and Dundonald Street and on the north side between Dundonald Street and Duckworth Street.

17. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 25 property owners on Amelia Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

18. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulations on Amelia Street from Albert Street to Duckworth Street at this time.

**AMELIA STREET – MULCASTER STREET TO THE EAST LIMIT**

19. Amelia Street between Mulcaster Street and the east limit is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.0 metres and no sidewalks please refer to Appendix "B".
20. Parking is prohibited anytime on the south side only of Amelia Street between Collier Street and the east limit.

21. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 6 property owners on Amelia Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

22. After review, staff recommend that Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended by adding the following:

<u>"Amelia Street</u>	North side from Berczy Street to the east limit	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."
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**BERCZY STREET – CODRINGTON STREET TO COLLIER STREET**

23. Berczy Street between Codrington Street and Collier Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and a sidewalk on the east side, please refers to Appendix "C".
24. Currently, parking is prohibited anytime on the west side of Berczy Street between Codrington Street and Collier Street. This was implemented in 2012 to improve winter maintenance activities. There is also no parking on the east side of Berczy Street between Eugenia Street and Codrington Street 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday this was implemented when St. Mary's School grounds were located in the area.

25. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 35 property owners on Berczy Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

26. After review, staff recommend a three (3) hour daytime parking limit on Berczy Street from Codrington Street to Collier Street be implemented to match other parking restrictions in the area to reduce confusion for vehicles parking.
27. The current no parking anytime on the west side is optimal for winter maintenance as vehicles travel southbound downhill on Berczy Street.
28. The current no parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday on Berczy Street between Codrington Street and Collier Street was implemented when St. Mary's school ground was located in this area. Since St. Mary's school is no longer there staff recommend the no parking be removed.
29. That Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "B" "No Parking in Specified Places Where Signs on Display at Stated Times" be amended and delete the following:

"Berczy Street                      East side in front of St. Mary's School Grounds                      8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays."

30. Staff recommend that Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended by adding the following:

"Berczy Street                      East side from Codrington Street to Collier Street                      Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."

**CODRINGTON STREET – MULCASTER STREET TO DUNDONALD STREET**

31. Codrington Street between Mulcaster Street and Dundonald Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 9.0 metres and a sidewalk on both sides. Please refer to Appendix "D".

32. Stopping is prohibited anytime on both sides of Codrington Street between Mulcaster Street and Berczy Street. There is no parking anytime on the north side of Codrington Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street. There is a two (2) hour parking limit Monday to Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the south side of Codrington Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street.
33. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 46 property owners on Codrington Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

34. Although residents voted in favour of leaving current parking regulations in place on Codrington Street between Mulcaster Street and Dundonald Street, staff recommend that the current two (2) hour parking limit on Codrington Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street be amended to a three (3) hour parking limit to standardize time restricted parking near the Downtown Core and reduce confusion for vehicles parking.
35. Staff recommend that Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended by deleting the following:

<u>"Codrington Street</u>	South side from a point 90 metres east of Berczy Street to Donald Street	Two (2) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory holidays"
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And add the following:

<u>"Codrington Street</u>	South side from a point 90 metres east of Berczy Street to Dundonald Street	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory holidays"
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**COLLIER STREET – MULCASTER STREET TO DUNDONALD STREET**

36. Collier Street between Mulcaster Street and Dundonald Street is a collector roadway with a pavement width of 11.0 metres with a sidewalk on both sides, please refer to Appendix "E".



37. Parking is prohibited anytime on both sides of Collier Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street. Permit Parking is permitted on the north side of Collier Street between Poyntz Street and Berczy Street and a two (2) hour parking limit on the south side of Collier between Poyntz Street and Berczy Street.
38. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 65 property owners on Collier Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

39. After review, staff recommend that the current two (2) hour parking limit on Collier Street between Poyntz Street and Berczy Street be amended to a three (3) hour parking limit to standardize time restricted parking near the Downtown Core and reduce confusion for vehicles parking.
40. Staff recommend that Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended by deleting the following:

<u>Collier Street</u>	South side from Poyntz Street to Berczy Street	Two (2) hours from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."
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And add the following:

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**EUGENIA STREET – BERCZY STREET TO DUNDONALD STREET**

41. Eugenia Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres with a sidewalk on the north side between Berczy Street and Albert Street.
42. Parking is prohibited anytime on the north side of Eugenia Street between Berczy Street and Albert Street.

43. No parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory Holidays on the south side of Eugenia Street between Berczy Street and Albert Street. There is no parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory Holidays on both sides of Eugenia Street between Albert Street and Dundonald Street.
44. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 64 property owners on Eugenia Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

45. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulation on Eugenia Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street at this time.

**POYNTZ STREET – BER CZY STREET TO COLLIER STREET**

46. Poyntz Street between Berczy Street and Collier Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and no sidewalks.
47. Parking is prohibited on both sides of Poyntz Street between Berczy Street and Collier Street 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday excluding Statutory Holidays.

48. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 15 property owners on Poyntz Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

49. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulation on Poyntz Street between Berczy Street and Collier Street at this time.

**THERESA STREET – BERCZY STREET TO DUNDONALD STREET**

50. Theresa Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 9.0 metres and no sidewalks.
51. Parking is prohibited anytime on the north side of Theresa Street between Dundonald Street and the top of the hill.
52. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 19 property owners on Theresa Street and adjacent roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

53. Residents were in favour of implementing a three (3) hour parking limit on Theresa Street, however staff did not observe any overflow parking from the Downtown Core and recommend leaving current parking in place to provide on-street parking.
54. After review, staff did not observe negative parking operations and do not recommend amending the current parking regulation on Theresa Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street at this time.

**WORSLEY STREET – MULCASTER STREET TO BERCY STREET**

55. Worsley Street between Mulcaster Street and Berczy Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 12.5 metres and sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
56. Parking is prohibited anytime on the north side of Worsley Street between Mulcaster Street and Berczy Street. On-street parking meters are in place on the south side of Worsley Street between Mulcaster Street and Poyntz Street.
57. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to 12 property owners on Worsley Street and surrounding roadways. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

58. After review, staff do not recommend amending the current parking regulation on Poyntz Street between Berczy Street and Collier Street at this time.

**BERCZY STREET AND SAMPSON STREET – COLLIER STREET TO DUNLOP STREET**

- 59. Berczy Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and a sidewalk on the east side, please refer to Appendix "F".
- 60. Sampson Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street is a local roadway with a pavement width of 8.5 metres and a sidewalk on the west side.
- 61. Parking is currently permitted on both sides of Berczy Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street.
- 62. Parking is currently prohibited on the west side of Sampson Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street.
- 63. A Parking Questionnaire was prepared and mailed to property owners on Berczy Street and Poyntz Street. Results of the Questionnaire are as follows:

Option B - Implement a three (3) hour parking limit 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday to Friday excluding Statutory Holidays. I. On the east side of Sampson Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street; and II. On the east and west side of Berczy Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street.	1	17%

- 64. Although residents voted in favour of leaving current parking regulations in place on Berczy Street and Sampson Street between Collier Street and Dunlop Street, staff recommend that a three (3) hour parking limit which would prevent long duration parking and provide opportunities for residents to park on-street.
- 65. After review, staff recommend Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "A" "No Parking Any Time" be amended and add the following:

"Berczy Street                      East side Collier Street to Dunlop Street                      Any Time

- 66. After review, staff recommend that Traffic By-law 80-138 Schedule "C" "Restricted Parking Between the Hours as Specified Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays for a Limited Time During Stated Hours Except on Statutory Holidays" be amended by adding the following:

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<u>"Berczy Street</u>	West side from Collier Street to Dunlop Street	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."
<u>"Sampson Street</u>	East side from Collier Street to Dunlop Street	Three (3) hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday except Statutory Holidays."

67. Staff will continue to monitor parking operations to evaluate the effectiveness of the amendments.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS**

68. There are no environmental matters related to the recommendation.

### **ALTERNATIVES**

69. There are two alternatives available for consideration by General Committee:

#### **Alternative #1**

General Committee could maintain the current two (2) hour parking limit on Collier Street between Poyntz Street and Berczy Street, and on Codrington Street between Berczy Street and Dundonald Street.

This alternative is not recommended as the proposed three (3) hour parking implementation would standardize time restricted parking near the Downtown Core.

#### **Alternative #2**

General Committee could decide not to implement a three (3) hour parking limit on Berczy Street between Codrington Street and Collier Street, and Amelia Street between Mulcaster Street and the east limit.

This alternative is not recommended as staff observed overflow from the Downtown Core negatively impacting residential roadways and wanted to improve operations. The proposed three (3) hour limit would prevent overflow parking for long durations and provide opportunities for residents to park on-street.

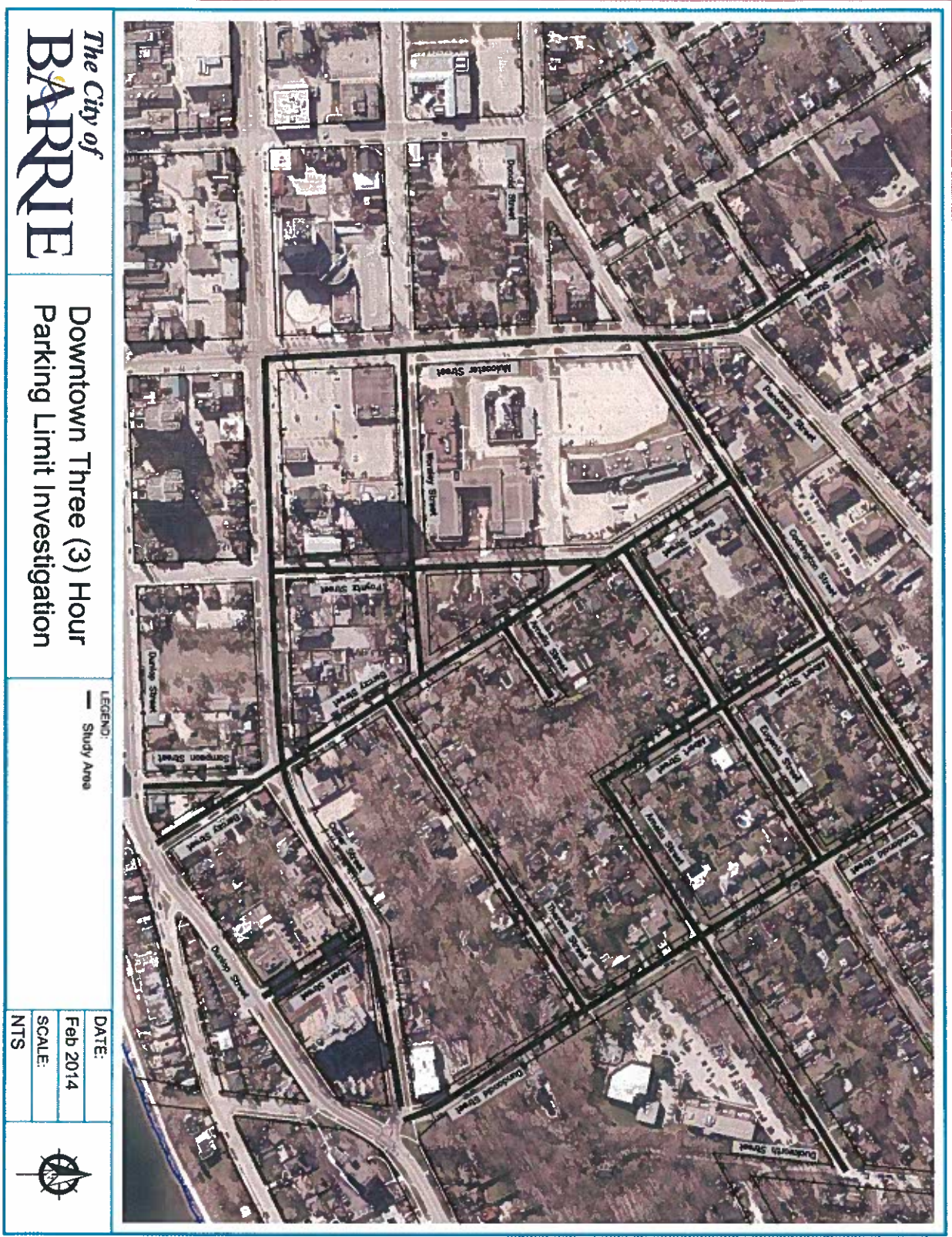
### **FINANCIAL**

70. The cost to implement the three (3) hour parking limit on Amelia Street, Berczy Street, Codrington Street, and Collier Street would be approximately \$3,300 and could be accommodated within the 2014 Operating Budget.

71. The recommendations included in this Staff Report are not specifically related to the goals identified in the 2010-2014 City Council Strategic Plan.

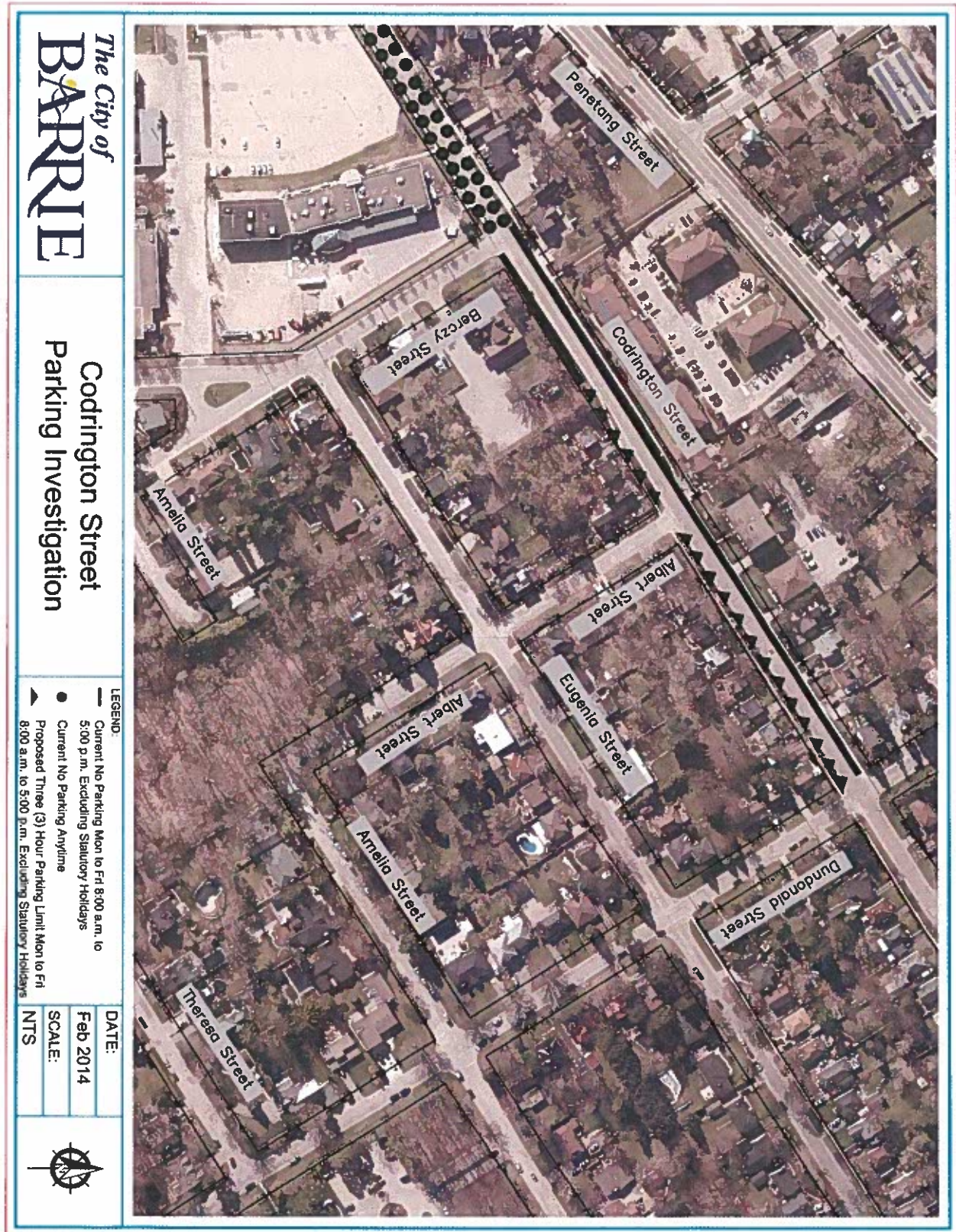
**Berczy Street
