RECOMMENDED MOTION

- That the continued support for rooftop solar project in industrial, commercial and institutional
 areas of that meet the City of Barrie criteria be addressed by providing a Blanket Council Support
 Resolution for the Provinces Feed in Tariff program Version 3.1, such resolution shall be in the
 form attached as Appendix "A" to Staff Report FCT010-15 m.
- 2. That pursuant to the FIT Contract, where a new resolution is received in respect to projects in Barrie, suppliers will be recognized as fulfilling the requirements under Section 2.4 (d)(vii) of the FIT Contract, which may result in suppliers being offered Notice to Proceed in accordance with the terms of their respective FIT Contract(s).
- 3. That the sole purpose of this resolution is to enable suppliers to achieve Notice to Proceed under their FIT Contracts and may not be used for any other purpose of any form of municipal approval in relation to a FIT Contract or project or for any other purpose.
- 4. That the Director of Facilities and Transit or his/her designate, be authorized to issue, on behalf of the City of Barrie, an applicable Municipal Council Support Resolution (Blanket) Notice to Proceed to all eligible proponents in the Province's Feed in Tariff (FIT) Program Version 3.1. (FCT010-15) (File: E11-SO)

PURPOSE & BACKGROUND

Report Overview

- 5. The Independent Electricity Operator (IESO) has extended the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) version 3 procurement of renewable energy to applicants with projects deemed complete and acceptable, but not offered a contract by the IESO IN 2014. The IESO has created FIT version 3.1 for this extension of FIT 3.0 program. This process is separate from the recent FIT 4.0 support resolutions Council recently approved.
- 6. Council previously approved site specific support resolutions under FIT 3.0. Although purposely passed without an expiry date, the IESO now requires that applicants under FIT 3.1 reconfirm municipal support for their projects.

7. The Ministry of Energy has directed that these FIT 3.0 applicants, who applied with the support of a Municipal Council resolution, must reconfirm Municipal Council Support through new resolutions in the form prescribed by IESO.

ANALYSIS

- 8. The only projects eligible to use this Support Resolution are projects which have already received a Support Resolution from Council through FIT 3.0.
- 9. Without this Support Resolution, these approved projects will not be given a Notice to Proceed and will be unable to build their solar projects.
- 10. This report recommends Council provide a blanket support resolution for roof top solar projects in the form prescribed by the IESO because there are various projects in Barrie that were approved by the IESO and each would need a confirmation by-law otherwise.

ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

- 11. The following environmental matters have been considered in the development of the recommendation:
 - a) By providing the Support Resolution Council enables Suppliers under the FIT programs that have previously received a Support Resolution from Council and have been approved for a contract with FIT to construct their project.

ALTERNATIVES

12. The following alternatives are available for consideration by General Committee:

Alternative #1

General Committee could choose to not provide the supporting resolution.

This alternative is not recommended as it would mean solar roof top projects already supported by council would not be constructed.

FINANCIAL

13. There are no financial implications for the Corporation resulting from the proposed recommendation.

LINKAGE TO 2014-2018 COUNCIL STRATEGIC PLAN

- 14. The recommendation(s) included in this Staff Report support the following goals identified in the 2014-2018 City Council Strategic Plan:
