



**BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend By-law 80-138, as amended being a by-law to regulate traffic on highways.**

**WHEREAS** Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 ("the Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein, *inter alia* highways;

**AND WHEREAS** by motions 14-G-262 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to further amend By-law 80-138 as amended, being a by-law to regulate traffic on highways.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-law 80-138, Schedule "E", "Taxicab Stands" be repealed and replaced with the Schedule "E" – "Taxicab Stands" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 24th day of November, 2014.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 24th day of November, 2014.
