PRESENTATION BY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BRANCH CONCERNING ENFORCEMENT SERVICES 101

Tammy Banting, Manager of Enforcement Services and Bryan Keene, Supervisor of Enforcement Services, discussed slides concerning the following topics:

• Background information related to staff, community engagement, enforcement, and regulation of policy and procedure development;

- Provincial regulations enforcement, for example AGCO/OLG lottery licensing, Dog Owners Liability Act, Pitbull Control Regulations etc.
- Information related to general patrol hours, live answer availability, afterhours message bank and priority sequences.

Members of Committee asked a number of questions to the presenters and received responses.

Ms. Banting will provide a report to the Committee by the end of July 2025, outlining where the parking issues are across the City as well as where they are coming from regarding proactive enforcement, complaint-based, etc.
