The Communities in Bloom Committee met and discussed the following:

ORIENTATION FOR THE COMMITTEE

Tara McArthur, Deputy City Clerk provided a presentation regarding an Orientation for the 2022 to 2026 Committee Members.

2023 COMMUNITIES IN BLOOM PROGRAM

She advised that the application has been submitted for the City's to participate in the 2023 Communities in Bloom Program in the "Non Competitive Circle of Excellence" award category, and that the colour theme will be purple flowers. Ms. Boyd anticipates that the Communities in Bloom judges will be in Barrie between July 25th to July 27th, 2023.

The Committee provided suggestions on promoting the Communities in Bloom program to increase participation such as providing more community engagement, communications, attending events and identifying supporters and sponsors.

The Committee discussed the registration fee for the Communities in Bloom Program. The Committee approved an expenditure from the Communities in Bloom budget of \$2375.00 to be submitted to Communities in Bloom organization for the 2023 registration fee.
