



BY-LAW NUMBER 2011-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend By-law 80-138, as amended, being a By-law to regulate traffic on highways.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 ("the Municipal Act, 2001"), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that Sections 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein, *inter alia* highways,

WHEREAS by motion 11-G-147 it is deemed expedient that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie amend By-law 80-138 as amended, being a by-law to regulate traffic on highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-law 80-138, "**Schedule "S" – Providing for the Erection of Stop Signs at Intersections**" be amended by adding the following temporary stop in alphabetical order:

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>Intersection</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>Facing Traffic</u>
"Huronia Road and McKay Road East (formerly 10th line)	Eastbound and Westbound on McKay Drive (formerly 10th line) and Northbound and Southbound on Huronia Road"

- 2.. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 13th day of June, 2011.

READ a third time and finally passed this 13th day of June 2011.
