The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning key programming, rental, and special event activities taking place during the month of November. The calendar in Appendix 'A' represents a summary of larger planned events taking place throughout our many recreation and cultural venues next month.

The City of Barrie Recreation and Culture team continues to thrive throughout the month of November. This month is filled with a wide range of events and activities that showcase the diversity of our community. With cultural events, festive celebrations, sports and theatre, there are plenty of opportunities for residents and visitors of Barrie to engage, connect and participate throughout our facilities all month long.

A Remembrance Day ceremony is planned for November 11. On November 16th, The Barrie Santa Clause Parade, which is sponsored by the Barrie Chamber of Commerce, will be taking place along Lakeshore Dr & Dunlop St. This event brings together residents and visitors to celebrate the holiday season.

The theatres provide numerous opportunities to experience a variety of shows like a Fleetwood Mac tribute on November 1st presented by Beach Towel Communications and Matilda Jr. the Musical from November 22-24th presented by Kempenfelt Community Players performing at Georgian Theatre. Five Points Theatre showcases Grand Pitch by Georgian College on November 19th.

At the City's arenas, a variety of events will be taking place in November. Sadlon Arena hosts three key events in November: the Christmas Craft Show presented by Area Productions Inc. from the 1st-3rd; the Rock 95 Birthday Bash on the 8th; and The Arkells in concert at Sadlon Arena on the 29th. The BWA Fall Sharkfest Tournament takes place November 15th-17th at multiple arenas across the city.

November sees many exciting events at facilities throughout Barrie, such as a Diwali event on November 9th at the General John Hayter Southshore CC. Parkview Community Centre hosts a Luncheon for the 55+ community on November 19th, and the Curling Canada Victory Banquet takes place November 24th at the General John Hayter Southshore CC. This banquet is the closing event of the 2024 Everest Canadian Curling Club Championships taking place at the Barrie Curling Club from November 18th-24th.

East Bayfield Community Centre's pool hosts swim meets November 1st-3rd and November 29th-December 1st, presented by the Barrie Trojan Swim Club.
