

COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING SUBMISSION NO. B58/24

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been received from **MHBC Planning c/o Kory Chisholm on behalf of 375 Yonge Street Inc.** for consent under Section 53 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended for a consent to a conveyance of property.

IN THE MATTER OF the premises described as Part S Part Lot 11 Concession 14 Innisfil, Part 1 51R31214 and known municipally as 375 Yonge Street in the City of Barrie.

The property is zoned General Commercial (C4).

The application, if granted by the Committee of Adjustment, will serve to permit the creation of an access easement over 375 Yonge Street in favour of 389-393 Yonge Street.

The proposed easement (shown on the attached sketch) will have an area of 244 square metres and width of 15 metres.

This application is being considered concurrently with applications B57/24 and A97/24.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Committee of Adjustment public hearing has been scheduled for **Tuesday, December 17, 2024.** This public meeting will be held in a virtual forum with electronic participation. The application and others will be heard commencing at **5:00 p.m. via ZOOM.**

Although this is a public hearing, you are not required to attend unless you wish to speak to the application. If you have specific comments regarding this application, you may submit comments to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee of Adjustment at cofa@barrie.ca.

Every attempt should be made to file your submission six days prior to the Public Hearing date. Notice of the decision will be provided to each person who appeared in person or by authorized representative at the hearing and who files with the Secretary-Treasurer a written request for notice of the decision. If you do not attend, the hearing will proceed in your absence, and you will receive no further notice. You must register and attend the hearing to receive further notice.


