KIDS READ OVER 22,000 BOOKS AT OUR SUMMER READING CLUB

Our 2023 Summer Reading Club has officially wrapped up, and what a summer it was! Nearly 1700 children and 90 teens took part this year and were more engaged than ever. Children logged a staggering 22,376 books read, and teens logged 668 books. Our Summer Reading Club is a fantastic way to foster a love of reading and keep kids engaged during the break from school.

It's not just about reading books, though - thousands of residents took part in fun, educational programs all summer long. From science experiments and visits with farm animals, to bike rodeos and escape rooms, families had endless opportunities to discover and learn for free.









BARRIE DRAGON BOAT FESTIVAL RAISES \$47,000

Saturday, August 19 was a beautiful day on Kempenfelt Bay! Close to 700 paddlers took their energy to the water and paddled in unison during our Barrie Dragon Boat Festival presented by Tim Hortons.

This year, we welcomed 26 teams from businesses, charities, government offices and groups of friends, who together raised \$47,000 (and counting!) for local charities, including our Future Branches Campaign.
