To Mayor Lehman and Members of counsel Please share this letter with the circulation list.

I am writing you in hopes that some changes can be made to the bus schedule. The new system implemented July 27th has reduced the start times on most buses. Therefore I am unable to make it to work on time. As an employee servicing the city through our healthcare system I am highly concerned about my safety and my ability to provide efficient care to those in our city. As I am sure you are aware that RVH is one of the largest employers of Barrie.

I have studied the maps and spoke with city workers to find my best possible way to work in the morning. As I live on Burton and Bayview and need to make it to RVH for 630 at the latest. My only option is to walk to the downtown terminal to catch the 8ANB. There is no bus leaving from the Allendale station to be able to transfer to the 8ANB. I no longer can use the 3 bus as I did previously as the earliest it leaves the downtown terminal is 650.

So as you can see this is quite concerning to me. None the less am I having to walk alone at a earlier hour, I will be unable to do so once the weather changes. I am already spending \$50 every weekend because the buses do not start early enough to make it to work. Now I am foreseeing having to pay even more just to get to the terminal. I am a single income family and already struggle financially. I will not be able to pay monthly pass fees and cab rides.

In order for me to provide proper care I would like to be at work <u>and ready</u> for 0645. So please, I am asking you to have a bus leaving Allendale Waterfront hub northbound in order to transfer to 8ANB for 0550.
