Day one of the Manufacturing Innovation Summit will be held at Georgian College. The event will kick off with a networking reception presented by BDC, followed by an expert talk, a highly engaging panel discussion focused on trends and opportunities in the automotive sector, and a tour of the world-class Alectra Centre for Research, Innovation and Commercialization at Georgian College including an industry showcase.
