

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-**

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend By-law 2005-149 a by-law to provide for the delegation of authority to approve the acquisition of real property within the City of Barrie.

**AND WHEREAS** Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides the power of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

**WHEREAS** Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.M.25, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 227, of the Municipal Act, 2001, it is the role of the officers and employees of the municipality to implement council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out council's decisions; to undertake research and provide advise to council on the policies and programs of the municipality and to carry out other duties as required under this or any Act and other duties assigned by the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Barrie enters into various standard agreements with regard to the acquisition of real property related to capital projects or operating budgets approved by the Council in the annual budget;

**AND WHEREAS** by motion 14-G-043, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-149 being a by-law to delegate the authority to approve these standard agreements to the City Clerk, or their designate;

**AND WHEREAS** the Legal Services Department of the Corporate and Community Services Division is charged with the responsibility for the acquisition, disposition, lease or licence of real property.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Section 2, of By-law 2005-149 be amended to replace the words "annual report to General Committee" with the words "annual memorandum".
- 2. **THAT** this by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.

**READ** a first and second time this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2014.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2014.
