The Heritage Barrie Committee met and reports as follows:

SECTION "A"

LIST OF PROPERTIES - POTENTIAL AWARD RECIPIENTS

The Committee met and discussed a list of commercial and residential properties provided by the Committee members as potential award recipients as owners of properties of heritage interest within the community.

The Committee will finalize their selection of four properties at a future meeting. The awards will be presented at the Barrie Heritage Celebration 2012.

HERITAGE RESOURCE CENTRE

K. Brislin, Senior Policy Planner advised the Committee that the local chapter of the Ontario Professional Planners Institute, Lakeland Planners (Simcoe Muskoka Area) have offered their support with the Barrie Heritage Celebration 2012 and have recommended a potential speaker to participate in the event.

“HERITAGE MONTH” - UPDATE

The Committee met and discussed plans for the first annual “Heritage Month” to be held during September and October, 2012. The Committee agreed that this event should be formally known as the “Barrie Heritage Celebration 2012”.

The Committee discussed the benefit of forming subcommittees to continue the planning process for the event beyond the regularly scheduled monthly meetings.

2. That the Heritage Barrie Committee work with the Department of Culture and other organizations to promote the event.

SECTION "C"

DISCUSSION REGARDING THE HERITAGE REGISTER

K. Brislin, Senior Policy Planner provided the Committee with a list of properties of heritage interest on the Walking Tours whose owners did not provide objections to being placed on the Municipal Cultural Heritage Register. Ms. Brislin also provided a list of properties whose owners objected to having their properties listed.

The Committee discussed the selection of a group of property owners to contact with regards to being placed on the Register and the process involved to achieve this.

REPRESENTATION AT OTHER LOCAL HERITAGE ORGANIZATIONS

The Committee discussed the benefits of partnering with other Heritage related committees and organizations in order to increase awareness and share ideas concerning local Heritage Initiatives.
