


Yonge Street Elevation




South Elevation

Ground Floor Plan



Planning Framework








- General Commercial OP Designation

- C4 (H61) Zone
 - Retirement Home use requires rezoning
 - Proposed RA2-1(SP) Zone
 - Based on MU2 Mixed Use Zone standards
