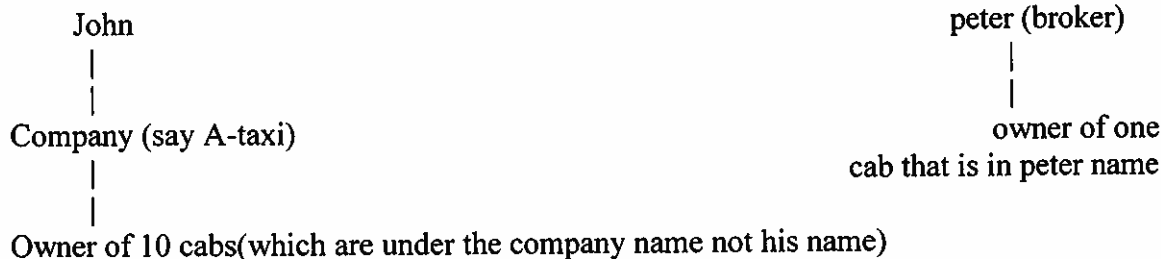

SUBJECT: Concerns regarding By Law 2006-265,1(a)ii

Dear Sir,

We are taxi cab owners/Brokers of City of Barrie. We have great concerns with the By Law 2006-265,1(a)ii, which is under process of amendment.

It states that “ Any person holding a valid taxi cab licence as of the date of the moratorium will be entitled to renew such licence annually or transfer licence to a new taxi cab but shall not be entitled to transfer a cab or a licence to a new owner. As mentioned above,taxi cab company owner can sell his company but being a individual broker we cant sell or transfer the cab licence to a new owner which is not justice. In our point of view it should be same for both of us (broker and company)we are trying to explain our case with an example given below:



John can sell or lease his company with 10 cabs to a new owner because all taxi business licence are in the name of A-taxi not in the name of owner but peter can't transfer his licence to a new owner , because that cab licence is in his name.

When John want to sell , he can sell the company. Or he can sell all the cars/taxies with the taxi licence to other owner because all the taxi licence are in the name of A-taxi (company) not in his personal name. he has a choice to sell the shares of the company or give a power of attorney or make a partnership deed with any body. But peter (broker), he has only one or two cabs in his name. he can,t sell his share or give power of attorney and cannot make a private deed with some other person.

That's why ,we are requesting you to make it clear before the finalizing the By law section 2006-265,1(a)ii.pl clear that if the company has the right to sell or share or power of attorney,then the single owner might have same right also.If it is approved as is , it will not be justice with a single owner.

Both parties are paying the same licence fees to the city of barrie then why company owner is entitled to sell or transfer his business to a new owner with all of his 10 cabs while the individual cab owner is not entitled to sell or transfer his business licence. In case if city is going to approve this By law as is , then please give us(all brokers) two week time so that we can transfer our cabs to the company name.

We will very thankful to you if you can make clear that law. (all cab brokers).
