

BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to appoint a Treasurer, a Deputy Treasurer and to repeal By-law 2014-165.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 ("the *Municipal Act*, 2001"), provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS Section 286(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a municipality shall appoint a treasurer who is responsible for handling all of the financial affairs of the municipality on behalf of and in the manner directed by the council of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS by motion 05-G-475 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to appoint a Treasurer.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Craig Brian Miller be appointed as Treasurer for the City of Barrie for the term of his employment.
- 2. **THAT** Colleen Jane Smith be appointed as a Deputy Treasurer for the City of Barrie for the term of her employment.
- 3. **THAT** By-law 2014-165 being a by-law to appoint Mary Patricia Elliott-Spencer as Treasurer and Colleen Jane Smith as a Deputy Treasurer, be repealed.
- 4. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the day of passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 30th day of March, 2015.

READ a third time and finally passed this 30th day of March, 2015.
