COMMITTEE BUDGET UPDATE

Tammie Maynard, Committee Support Clerk provided an update concerning the Committee's budget.

LEGACY FUND UPDATE

Dave Morrison, Chair provided an update concerning the Legacy Fund. Mr. Morrison provided information concerning the Barrie Community Foundation and creating grant procedures for youth ambassador donations. He discussed potential changes to the composition of the International Relations Committee to include a representative for the Legacy Fund on the Committee

INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS WEBSITE UPDATE

Ciaran Byles-Ho provided an update concerning the International Partners Website. Mr. Byles-Ho advised that a link to the City of Barrie's live camera feed and links to International partners webpages have been added to the website.

MURAYAMA, JAPAN UPDATE

Mark Sachkiw provided an update concerning Murayama, Japan, budget approvals and host families. He indicated that plans are to host an adult delegation from Murayama, Japan in 2023. Mr. Sachkiw advised that plans are for a youth delegation to travel to Murayama, Japan during summer of 2023.

YOUTH AMBASSADORS UPDATE

GERMAN TWINNING AND GERMAN CANADIAN CLUB REPORT

Jean Maurice Pigeon advised that Hans Etzel will be representing the German Twinning Committee on the International Relations Committee. Mr. Pigeon advised that a delegation from Zweibrucken, Germany will be arriving in Barrie on September 4th, 2022. He explained that granite bench will be unveiled at the Southshore Centre in recognition of the 25th Anniversary of the Barrie's twinning relationship with Zweibrucken, Germany.

Mr. Pigeon advised that the Knights of Columbus and German Canadian club will be hosting Oktoberfest on September 10th, 2022.
