PROVISION OF SANITARY AND WATER SERVICING, ESSA ROAD, FERNDALE DRIVE TO COUGHLIN ROAD (WARD 6 & 7)

1. That a by-law be prepared to authorize the recovery of capital costs for the installation of sanitary servicing of unserviced properties on Essa Road between Ferndale Drive and Coughlin Road, as outlined in Staff Report ENG006-14, through the collection of a per metre frontage charge plus lateral costs for benefiting properties abutting the proposed new sections of sanitary sewer, as provided under Section 326 of the Municipal Act, with the option of payment of the sanitary charges over a 10 year period with interest.

2. That a by-law be prepared to authorize the recovery of capital costs for the installation of water servicing on Essa Road between Ferndale Drive and Coughlin Road, as outlined in Staff Report ENG006-14, through the collection of a per metre frontage charge plus lateral costs for benefiting properties abutting the proposed new sections of watermain, as provided under Section 326 of the Municipal Act, with the option of payment of the water charges over a 10 year period interest free.  - Storm Water Drainage & Control Systems Former City Municipal Boundary Areas (11-05-0530) - formerly known as Storm Water Mgmnt; and

APPLICATIONS FOR OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT AND ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT - SUMMITPINES ESTATES INC. - 301, 311, 343 TOWN LINE ROAD (COUNTY ROAD 27) & 38 HUMBER STREET (WARD 6)

- 1. That the Official Plan Amendment application submitted by the Jones Consulting Group Ltd., on behalf of Summitpines Estates Inc., for lands known municipally as 301, 311, 343 Town Line Road (County Road 27) and 38 Humber Street (Ward 6), be approved as follows:
 - a) Amend Official Plan Schedule "A" Land Use to redesignate the subject lands from Open Space to Residential, Open Space and Environmental Protection; and
 - b) Amend Ardagh Secondary Plan Schedule 2 Land Use to redesignate the subject lands from Open Space and Environmental Protection to Low Density Residential, Open Space and Environmental Protection.

- 2. That the Zoning By-law Amendment application submitted by the Jones Consulting Group Ltd., on behalf of Summitpines Estates Inc., for lands known municipally as 301, 311, 343 Town Line Road (County Road 27) and 38 Humber Street (Ward 6) from Open Space (OS) (SP-118) and Residential Single Detached Dwelling First Density (R1) to Residential Detached Dwelling Third Density (R3), Residential (R4), Residential Single Detached Detached Dwelling Fourth Density Dwelling Third Density Holding (R3)(H), Open Space (OS) Environmental Protection (EP) be approved.
- 3. That the By-law for the purpose of lifting the Holding Provision (H) from the Zoning By-law Amendment as it applies to the lands municipally known as 301, 311, 343 Town Line Road (County Road 27) and 38 Humber Street, shall be brought forward for approval once the owner provides the following to the satisfaction of the City of Barrie:
 - a) That the extension of Street "B" has been secured to the satisfaction of the City of Barrie.
